ANF Corporate Sunday Worship Guideline via a Virtual Platform March 22, 2020

Guidelines

- ANF will have Sunday Corporate Worship via a virtual platform.
- We will create randomized groups of ANF members on a rotating basis.
- Though we will not be meeting in person, we (each group) will all start at the same time (2:00pm) so that we are worshipping together.
- Imagine that you are attending a regular Sunday Corporate Worship. Therefore, no lying on bed, no pajamas, wash your face and take a shower before it begins. Prepare your Bible, a pen and a note to have with you. Participate in Sunday Corporate Worship with a reverent heart.
- Laptops or computers are preferable for the video call. Use your phone for the time of praise, offering, commitment, etc.
- Each group will have a Worship Facilitator (**WF**). (Pastor Daniel will choose different WFs each week to give several ANF members an opportunity to lead, which should also be instructive on how others can lead Sunday Corporate Worship in the future.)
- The WF is responsible for informing his/her group members on how to join his/her specific ANF Virtual Sunday Corporate Worship group by Saturday noon and inviting them to join his/her online call by Sunday at 1:50 pm through **Skype**.

Greeting

- Say “Hi,” and “Shalom,” to one another.

Call to Worship (led by WF)

For a little while, we will no longer be able to gather in our church building for Sunday Corporate Worship. Instead, we will gather together to worship God via a virtual platform. Although our circumstances may have changed, nothing can change the love of God for us or our desire to worship our faithful and loving Father.

Silent Prayer

Let's prepare our hearts to worship in spirit and in truth by praying to God silently for one minute, so that we can enter into the presence of the Holy Spirit.

- Pray for one minute in silence.
 - The WF can prepare music to play in the background.

- After one minute, the WF will close with the following prayer:

Father God, we are here to worship you. Many things have changed, but Your love for us remains the same. In all circumstances, we want to give thanks to You and praise Your name. During our worship today, help us to experience Your presence, Your healing, Your hope, Your peace and Your love. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.

Praise

- Two songs will be selected by the ANF praise team leader each week, and they will be posted in the ANF GroupMe chatroom by Saturday at 11:00 am.
 1. *Love Came Down* (Bethel Music)
 2. *Give Thanks* (Don Moen)

Prayer

- Each WF will ask one group member to pray for worship by Saturday noon.
- The person assigned will write his/her prayer in advance and read it during this time.

Offering/Tithing

- Each WF will inform group members how to give, either through **Venmo** or through the ANF website using the “**Give**” link.
- Please have everyone take time to do this during this offering time specifically.
 - If, for some reason, it is not possible for anyone to give during this time, WFs should remind group members immediately after the virtual Sunday Corporate Worship so as to not forget.

Bible Reading

- Open the Bible and read the sermon verses together.

Sermon

- Listen together to Pastor Daniel's pre-recorded message.

Commitment and Intercessory Prayer

- Let's take some time to respond to God's message personally and practically.

- Pray with the following prayer requests for at least one minute:
 - (1) For the spread of COVID-19 to come to a halt, and for a vaccine to be developed soon, as well as for infected people to recover from the virus.
 - (2) For our society's leaders to exercise good leadership, and for everyone to be able to get through this difficult time well with wisdom, courage, and love.
 - (3) For God to protect and watch over our families, both biological and spiritual, from COVID-19.
 - (4) For us to be able to distinguish God's will and become more mature Christians through this time.

Closing Benediction (led by WF)
