All Nations Fellowship Sunday Corporate Worship via ZOOM March 29, 2020

Guidelines

- In response to the ongoing COVID-19 crisis, All Nations Fellowship (ANF) will begin holding Sunday Corporate Worship via a virtual platform starting March 22, 2020.
- This Sunday, March 29, 2020, we will be using ZOOM for our Sunday Corporate Worship. ZOOM is able to accommodate our entire congregation under *one* virtual space.
- In order to find the most suitable system for our needs, we will be experimenting with various virtual platforms for the next several weeks.
- Shepherds will help their house church members download the ZOOM app and send them an invitation link on Sunday.
- Even though we will not be meeting in person, Sunday Corporate Worship via ZOOM will begin at our normal time of 2:00 pm, so that we are all worshipping at the same time. People are encouraged to log in five minutes in advance of service to greet one another.
- Imagine that this is a regular Sunday Corporate Worship. No lying in bed, no pajamas, take a shower before logging on, etc. Prepare your Bible, a pen and a notebook to have with you during the service. Participate in Sunday Corporate Worship with a reverent heart.
- Laptops or computers are preferable for the video call. Use your phone for the time of praise, offering, commitment, etc.

Call to Worship

Silent Prayer

- Praise Team (PT) prepares music to play in the background.
- Magnification Team (Mag. T) mutes the audio of all participants, excluding Pastor Daniel and PT.

Praise

- PT leads the congregation in a time of praise.
- Mag. T shares the PowerPoint onto the screen.

Prayer

- The designated person writes his or her prayer in advance and reads it during this time.
- Mag. T to make sure that everyone's audio is still muted, excluding Pastor Daniel, PT and the person reading the prayer.

Offering/Tithing

- PT leads the congregation in the song of offering.
- Mag. T to make sure that everyone's audio is still muted, excluding Pastor Daniel and PT.
- Mag. T to coordinate the PowerPoint on the screen (*Lyrics and How to Give*).
- The congregation partakes in a time of offering, also singing along to the song of offering.

Offering (Paul Baloche)

ANF News (Announcements)

- Mag. T to mute the audio of PT.
- Mag. T to coordinate the PowerPoint on the screen.

Bible Reading

- Everyone opens their Bibles and reads the sermon verses together.
- Mag. T to coordinate the PowerPoint on the screen.

Sermon

- Mag. T to make sure that everyone's audio is still muted, excluding Pastor Daniel.

Song of Commitment

- PT leads the congregation in the song of commitment.
- Mag. T to make sure that everyone's audio is still muted, excluding Pastor Daniel.
- Mag. T to coordinate the PowerPoint on the screen.
