### Good Friday Service Guidelines via Zoom (April 10, 2020)

*Imagine that you are with Jesus, as he is praying in agony at Gethsemane, as he is being crucified at Golgotha, as he is speaking out his last words and as his body is being placed in the tomb by Joseph from Arimathea.*

- Let's participate in Good Friday Worship with a reverent heart.
- Prepare a candle and light it at the beginning of service.
- Print out the guidelines and hymns or have them ready on another device so that you can fully participate in the video call via *Zoom*.
- This year, we will meditate on the seven last words of Jesus Christ on the cross.
- For each passage, the person assigned will read the verses listed and share his or her reflection on the Word.
- Following each reading, let's sing a hymn together, reflecting on the love of Jesus Christ expressed through the cross and praying silently in our hearts.

### The Seven Last Words of Jesus on the Cross

#### 1. Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.

*And when they came to the place that is called The Skull, there they crucified him, and the criminals, one on his right and one on his left. And Jesus said, "**Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.**" And they cast lots to divide his garments. (Luke 23:33-34)*

#### 2. You will be with me in paradise.

*One of the criminals who were hanged railed at him, saying, "Are you not the Christ? Save yourself and us!" But the other rebuked him, saying, "Do you not fear God, since you are under the same sentence of condemnation? And we indeed justly, for we are receiving the due reward of our deeds; but this man has done nothing wrong." And he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." And he said to him, "**Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise.**" (Luke 23:39-43)*

#### 3. Behold, your son! Behold, your mother!

*When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to his mother, "**Woman, behold, your son!**" Then he said to the disciple, "**Behold, your mother!**" And from that hour the disciple took her to his own home. (John 19:26-27)*

#### 4. Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?

*And when the sixth hour had come, there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour. And at the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, "**Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?**" which means, "**My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?**" (Mark 15:33-34)*

### 5. I thirst.

*After this, Jesus, knowing that all was now finished, said (to fulfill the Scripture), “**I thirst.**” A jar full of sour wine stood there, so they put a sponge full of the sour wine on a hyssop branch and held it to his mouth. (John 19:28-29)*

### 7. Father, into your hands, I commit my spirit.

*It was now about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour while the sun's light failed. And the curtain of the temple was torn in two. Then Jesus, calling out with a loud voice, said, “**Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!**” And having said this he breathed his last. (Luke 23:44-46)*
